LIABILITY

Parents are directly responsible for their children's actions. Compensation for injury or

damages, deliberate or accidental, shall be borne entirely by the responsible family.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

E.A.G.L.E. recognizes that our organization exists on the good will of all of the families who participate, and it is only fair that no one student be allowed to create an atmosphere that detracts from our children's ability to learn and form lasting friendships. It is for this reason that the Leadership Team retains the right to take any

reasonable disciplinary action to maintain a warm and friendly environment.

When a student is disruptive in class, he will be sent to the Leader in charge and then, if

necessary, to that student's supervising adult. The child will be able to return to his class that day at the teacher's discretion.

If the offense occurs repeatedly, the parent may be asked to meet with the E.A.G.L.E. Leadership Team. The Leadership team has the authority to recommend that the student be expelled from E.A.G.L.E. If the child is asked to leave, the remaining portion

of his fees will be returned. It should be noted that only the most severe offenses should result in expulsion.

Any dispute arising from discipline issues or this discipline policy will be referred to the

E.A.G.L.E. Leadership Team. The decision of the E.A.G.L.E. Leadership Team is final.

The parties understand that this method shall be the sole remedy for any controversy or

claim arising from this agreement and expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit in any

civil court for such disputes.

SICK POLICY

If you or your children are sick or recovering from an illness, please refrain from attending E.A.G.L.E. that week. We do not want E.A.G.L.E. to be a source of sickness for any family, so please use good judgment.

According to the American Public Health Association, illnesses and signs of illness include:

- Fever of 99 degrees or greater within 24 hours prior to E.A.G.L.E., or fever that needs medication to control
- Vomiting, even just once, or diarrhea within 24 hours prior to E.A.G.L.E.
- Colored or excessive nasal discharge that is heavy enough to require frequent wiping
- Persistent coughing or sneezing
- Streptococcal infection, until more than 24 hours after treatment has been initiated
- Other contagious symptoms, including but not limited to sore throat, rash, eye infections, lice, etc.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Children must be directly supervised at all times, whether outside or in the building. Also, please watch your children during playtime or ensure that an adult supervises their play.

2. If a parent leaves for a short time, each child at E.A.G.L.E. must have a supervising adult present.

3. Families who are at E.A.G.L.E. by the first class, please help move tables & chairs into the classrooms. Families who are at E.A.G.L.E. at the last class, please help move tables & chairs back into storage. Thank you!

4. Use only items and areas sanctioned for our use....classrooms, playground, eating area,

parking lot for vehicles only. Do not roam around!

5. Parents are responsible for their children's behavior and any damages incurred by their actions.

6. Label all supplies.

7. Do not bring anything that does not pertain to class, such as toys, electronics, bikes, laser pointers, skateboards, pocketknives, drugs and weapons (real or play).

8. We do not believe in banning cell phones, as relatives may need to reach you; just please be considerate with cell phone use.

9. Parents and students should wear appropriate modest clothing. If in doubt, choose something else. If the Leadership Team gets complaints, a dress code will be established.

10. Parents are responsible for their child/children during lunch. Be sure to clean up from your family's lunch if you eat at E.A.G.L.E.

11. To prevent spills and pest infestation, food is confined to the eating area or outside, unless part of a class function.

12. Please help your children clean up after their last class of the day.

13. If Cabell County schools are closed due to bad weather, E.A.G.L.E. will be canceled. If

Cabell County schools are delayed due to bad weather, E.A.G.L.E. will not be canceled.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Respect 4-H property and use only items and areas sanctioned for our use ...classrooms, playground, eating area, parking lot for vehicles only. Do not roam around! You will be held accountable for any damages caused by your actions.

2. Label all supplies with your name.

3. Do not bring anything that does not pertain to class, such as toys, electronics, bikes, laser pointers, skateboards, pocketknives, drugs and weapons (real or play).

4. Students may listen to music when not in class; otherwise, listening devices must be kept in their parent's car. Cell phones should not be used in class, unless receiving an emergency call or text from family members.

5. Students should wear appropriate modest clothing. If in doubt, choose something else. If the Leadership Team gets complaints, a dress code will be established.

6. Be in your assigned classes at all times while at E.A.G.L.E., with the exception of lunch, and do

not leave the classroom without the teacher's or helper's permission.

7. Help clean up when each class ends. Do not leave the room until cleaning is complete

8. To prevent spills and pest infestation, food is confined to the eating area, and picnic areas, unless part of a class function. Please clean up after your lunch.

9. Please follow the courtship standard for boy-girl relationships by respecting one another and refraining from public displays of affection.
